Choices for 2023

In 2023, we are focusing more strongly than before on **strengthening our profile** and **improving collaboration**. Now that the spatial frameworks are (as good as) established and the implementation of various plans is actually taking place, we are entering the next phase. A phase in which even more emphasis will be placed on establishing a strong HighTech Twente profile, to which the clusters of Kennispark seamlessly connect. We are also committed to stronger cooperation between all parties within that HighTech Twente playing field: from ecosystem builders such as Novel-T and Oost NL to the companies and the top workplaces, and from the knowledge institutions to the Twente Board and governments. A strong Twente proposition helps Kennispark better leverage its role as a job engine for the region. By joining forces and putting us even more strongly on the map nationally and internationally as a region, we can attract talent, businesses and activity. There are still too many untapped opportunities that we can only capitalize on together.

In this annual plan, we explain our choices on the basis of the four goals and the associated projects, supplemented by the partners with whom we want to achieve these goals.



Commitment to ambitions 2023

- The ambitions for 2023 have been agreed with key parties involved in implementation:
 - Municipality of Enschede, University of Twente, VONK, Oost NL, Novel-T, Twente Board, ASR DSPF and the top work locations.
- Not all sections in the annual plan contain hard kpi's, as it is part of an ongoing commitment to collaboration. All parties involved have expressed their intention to work together positively on the area ambitions. We can only achieve the ambitions if everyone does their agreed share.
- The Area Organization drives, monitors progress and ensures that all parties continue to work together toward the shared ambitions.
- Many projects in the present annual plan are part of multi-year projects, with an expected time span to 2026.

01. Add Innovation District Hengelosestraat - explanation

Why add an innovation district?

On the south side of Hengelosestraat, the municipality owns issuable land. At this spot we realize a new 'face' for Kennispark. On the north side of the Hengelosestraat, the University of Twente also has allocable land. By developing both sides together, we want to strengthen the connection between the UT campus and the Business & Science Park, both literally and figuratively, and give the area a new shared heart. There must be 'bustle' here 24/7, just like on the campus itself. This development forms the showpiece, the signboard, of the renewal at Kennispark. It is the engine behind the renewal and upgrading of the rest of the Business & Science Park.

Key project leaders

Many priority projects within the innovation district are at the point of implementation. All key projects form a complex interplay, with strong spatial and programmatic interconnections between them. Each key project has its own leader who is responsible for the actual realization, with the help of partners. These are listed for each project.

Role of Twente Knowledge Park

The role of the area organization within the key projects is a driving, directing function and ensuring that the right parties are brought together.



1. NEXT TWENTE

ASR Dutch Science Park Fund will search for potential tenants, draw up a program of requirements and come up with an initial design for a new multi-tenant building (NEXT Twente) with shared facilities for the entire area. A permit for realization is expected by the end of the year.

2. LIVING BUILDING

A total of approximately 290 housing units will be added at Kennispark: 200 housing units on the Business and Science Park for (young) professionals, PhD students and employees of Kennispark companies and 90 student housing units on the university campus. A permit for realization is expected by the end of the year.

3. PARKING BUILDING

The municipality is developing a business case and design for a parking building on Hengelosestraat. This parking building will be ready for delivery of NEXT Twente.

Planning:	start of construction 2024, delivery 2025
Contactor:	Municipality of Enschede
Partners involved:	ASR DSPF, VONK



Simultaneously with the realization of the priority projects, public spaces will be addressed in 2023 through 2025. The municipality of Enschede (Smart connection, public space) and the University of Twente (Markepad connection) are initiators of the projects.

4. THE SMART CONNECTION

The crossing over Hengelose Street near Institutes Road, including a meeting unit, will be completed by the municipality in early 2023.

5. CONNECTION TO THE MARKEPAD

On the side of the University of Twente we optimize the Markepad t.h.v. and simultaneously with the Smart Crossing.

6. DESIGN OF PUBLIC SPACE

The municipality is working with the surrounding owners and users on a joint design for the public space of the Innovation District on Hengelose Street. It is the joint intention to have the layout ready immediately after completion of the priority projects.



7. BUILDINGS ON THE UT SIDE

A program of requirements will be drawn up for the building space on the UT side, matching the cultural-historical and urban planning frameworks. This will take into account the programmatic wishes from the ecosystem. The UT is in the lead.

8. REALIZATION MEDTECH FACTORY

The MedTech Factory is expected to be realized in 2023 and will include labs and offices. Location is still unknown. Novel-T is pulling this process together with UT Holding.

02. Transformation of existing B&S park - explanation

Why transform the existing B&S park?

Given the limited space left for expansion at Kennispark, merely adding a new "face" and residential area along Hengelosestraat is not enough. The existing area should also be given a different, more campus-worthy, appearance.

We are therefore transforming the area into a campus situation where the outdoor space and buildings function as shared facilities. The space between the buildings invites to stay and meet, creating more, and at more times, liveliness.

Key project leaders

Within the existing B&S park, we are dealing with over 60 property owners. Together with the entrepreneurs, they have an important role in the realization of the area development, in which sustainability, mobility and parking are important pillars. Each project has its own leader who is responsible for the actual realization, with the help of partners. These are listed for each project.

Role of Kennispark Twente

The role of the area organization varies: in private and public developments it has a directing role. We are process manager for a number of sustainability and RegioDeal projects.

9. WATER & HEAT FEASIBILITY TEST

The municipality is investigating the feasibility of a water and heat network (off the grid) for Kennispark companies. An essential project for sustainable real estate developments.

10. OTHER SUSTAINABILITY PROJECTS

- Realization solar field Twente Village
- Certification BREEAM 3 stars Area
- Meeting facilities in green along the Innovation path

11. HMO DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTENWEG READY

HMO is developing several lots in 2023, including the relocation of the former Amsterdam law building as Techbank andTechhal and a parking building, with the help of the Green Deal.

12. DESIGN OF PUBLIC SPACE

The southern part of Institutenweg is expected to be redesigned in 2023 by the municipality and in agreement with affected property owners.

13. REDEVELOPMENT STATION AREA

If parking is to be provided at the Grolsch Veste, there must also be a safe walking or last-mile route to and from the B&S Park. The municipality will initiate talks with VONK and owners at Twente Village to come up with a design.

14. PARKING COVENANT & MOBILITY CHALLENGE

VONK, association for property owners and entrepreneurs at Kennispark, is entering into a parking covenant with the municipality to make room for greening the area. The mobility task is closely related to this.

15. THE GALLERY AND ITC

To be completed in 2023:

- The Gallery first floor extension, by ASR DSPF
- ITC and head of The Gallery, by University of Twente

16. HOUSING STRATEGY

The municipality will begin work on a housing strategy in 2023. What can go where in which property and how much? The retention of talent and (international) education will be included in the strategic choices. The municipality will involve partners such as Domijn, De Veste, SHE, IST and the student housing working group. This results in a map for possible future developments.

03. Strengthen Kennispark profile

Why strengthen the profile?

Over the years, companies have been established at Kennispark that have little relation to the university and no high-tech character. To transform Kennispark from a business park into an innovation campus, we want to steer more firmly on who is allowed to establish themselves at Kennispark. We also want to actively seek out companies that contribute to existing and new desired knowledge clusters at Kennispark. This requires a cluster approach and a strong focus on the profile in which we are strong. Within this cluster approach, the area boundaries are blurring and cohesion is needed with a strong high-tech Twente profile.

Trekkers key projects

Within Twente and the top work locations, various players are active on cluster approach, marketing/branding/lobbying, improving the ecosystem for high-tech Twente and knowledge valorization. 2023 will be the year in which we commit to further structuring the (overarching) cluster management in Twente.

Role of Kennispark Twente

Kennispark Twente is the booster of the HighTech Twente profile and makes in-kind contributions to certain clusters in Twente. It is the driving force behind its own (inter)national profile.

17. IMPLEMENT MEDTECH CLUSTER PLAN

Together with entrepreneurs and stakeholders, execute the cluster strengthening plan: facilities, financing instruments, community building, internationalization. Kennispark is the trigger for the following components:

- Strengthen interaction between MedTech companies and connect companies to facilities, incl. organization of MedTech Twente Week.
- New Business Community Manager is added to the core team and participates in the project implementation team.
- Independent research on talent needs of MedTech companies in collaboration with Saxion.
- Seating in direction team by area director.

18. CHIPTECH TWENTE AMBITION PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

Together with entrepreneurs and stakeholders, execute cluster strengthening plan: facilities, financing instruments, community building, internationalization. Kennispark will actively contribute to the following components:

- Strengthen interaction between ChipTech companies and connect companies to facilities. Participation in ChipTech Twente core team to steer Twente Board application in the right direction.
- Support in marketing & communication, also in relation to Pure Play Foundry.

NB: further details will follow after positive Twente Board decision. University of Twente and MESA+ are leading the roadmap and business case for the High Tech Foundry, for which a quartermaster will also be appointed.

19. CONNECTING AND SEEKING GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

To increase investment power and capture opportunities nationally and internationally, we are exploring ways to seek and connect grant opportunities within the ecosystem. The opportunities are diverse: think sustainability, research projects within clusters and spatial impulses. We take the initiative to take stock and then investigate where we can invest this structurally.

20. VISIBILITY IN AREA AND ONLINE

Kennispark has no visible markings in the area. It is not clear that you are entering a special science park. The area organization is investigating area markings, possibly linking traffic information, area information, events, innovations and visibility of companies. Also, the website will be revamped this year.

21. VISION SHARED FACILITIES I.R.T. BUILDINGS

Kennispark is taking the lead in establishing a vision for shared facilities. Which facilities will land where? This involves both (high-tech) facilities that strengthen the clusters in our ecosystem and functions for the area, such as housing, hospitality and retail in the plinth of existing and new buildings.

22. STRENGTHENING COOPERATION HIGH-TECH TWENTE & CLUSTER MANAGEMENT

Together with entrepreneurs, top working locations, knowledge institutions, eco-builders and municipalities, we are establishing a strong high-tech Twente profile, including marketing, branding, lobbying, PR, talent programs and acquisition. The Campus Cafés also fall under this. Twente Board takes the initiative for a direction team or facilitates it through funding. The clusters find a place within this high-tech Twente profile. Regarding the clusters, there must be agreement on who identifies, defines, finances and organizes clusters. Kennispark will take the initiative in this regard.

Goal: attract talent, companies and activity through visibility outside Twente.

23. PROFILING SHE (RAILROAD ZONE)

SHE has a similar need for profiling that can fit seamlessly with Twente's high-tech profile. We want to see whether we can link the spatial needs to our ecosystem and cluster approach and whether we can act together in the Twente lobby.

24. BACK OFFICE TOP WORK LOCATIONS

Collaboration on themes including marketing, funding, talent, clusters, locations/profiles and integration within the high-tech Twente collaboration. Examples are Challenged Based Learning and events such as Create Tomorrow and Dutch Innovation Days. Connection to HighTech Twente is obvious.
